## TEMPORARY STRUCTURE PERMITS

### SWIM RAFTS

- Display permit with 3” high numbers on 2 sides of the raft along with reflectors on all four sides.
- No more than 100 feet out from shore.
- Must be removed from the water by October 1<sup>st</sup> of each year.
- Swim raft permits are five year permits.

### SWIM AREAS

- You can mark off up to 2,500 sq ft, no more than 50 ft along lake frontage.
- Markers need be in place to designate the swim area. You can use bleach bottles with orange paint on each side.
- Place your permit number on the two outer markers.
- Swim area permits are five year permits.

### SLALOM SKI COURSES

- Permit number must be displayed on all floats.
- Permit does not give user exclusive rights to the water.
- Permit is to be issued only after the Lake Association has approved it.
- Course must be out of major boat traffic areas.
- Slalom ski course permits are one year permits.

### MOORING BUOYS

- Permit number must be displayed on the buoy.
- Must meet state specifications in regard to color and reflectorization.
- Generally must be within 100 feet of shore (including a boat’s swing on the buoy).
- Mooring buoy permits are five year permits.

### SKI JUMPS

- Permit number must be displayed on the jump.
- Jump must be lighted at night and sufficient reflectors displayed to indicate size.
- Jump must be out of major boat traffic areas and not a navigational hazard.
- Ski jump permits are one year permits.

### EVENT PERMITS

Proof of liability insurance is required and is to include the name of the company, policy number and limits of liability.

### ICE EVENT CONCERNS

- Parking.
- Police and traffic protection.
- EMS Staff or first aid provisions (depending on the event).
- Ice quality and thickness.
- Toilet facilities.

- Post event clean-up (see Snowmobile/Ice Events).

### OPEN WATER EVENTS

- DNR permit requirements for fishing contests.
- Buoying or marking the areas and determining the location of the spectator craft.
- EMS Staff or first aid provisions (depending on the event).
- Mandatory use of wearable life jackets for certain events.
- Adequate patrol, rescue and emergency/ response crafts provided by the event sponsor.

## SNOWMOBILE/ICE EVENTS

All debris (hay bales, paper, cardboard, cans, bottles, concessions stand garbage, etc.) is to be cleaned up and removed from the lake within 24 hours of the close of the race, sooner if much snow is forecasted.

All furrows, humps of snow, and ice ridges are to be leveled to pre-race condition immediately after the final race is over.

All race track grooming and snow removal machinery is to be left on site until after the inspection of the race is complete and to our satisfaction. Inspection of the area will be done by the DNR Conservation Officers and the Becker County Sheriff’s Department personnel.
