

Littleleaf Linden

Tilia cordata



- **Plant Characteristics:** Pyramidal in youth: upright-oval to pyramidal-rounded and densely branched in old age. Medium sized tree native to Europe.
- **Size:** Height: 30 to 60 ft.
Width: 20 ft. to 30 ft.
- **Foliage:** Dark shiny green above and light green undersides of leaves in summer changing to soft yellow in fall.
- **Flower:** Blooms in late June or early July
 - fragrant
 - bees are attracted to flowers
- **Fruit:** Small round nutlet, cream color and slightly ornamental.
- **Soil:** Grows well in deep, fertile, well-drained,

loam and clay soils. Prefers moist soils.

- **Tolerances:** Pollution tolerant, strong winds
- **USDA Hardiness Zone:** Zone 3-7
- **Light Range:** Full Sun ☀️ to light shade
- **pH:** 5.5–7.5 pH
- **Other:**
 - Found in limestone in the wild
 - Very pH adaptable
 - Long time in cultivation
 - Long lived
 - Used as hedges or windbreaks
 - Slow to moderate growth
 - Good for honey production
 - No major pest problems known
