

This is Mary Hendrickson your Becker County Auditor-Treasurer. Primary Election day is Tuesday, August 9, 2022. All registered voters received a WHITE postcard with your updated polling location and districts. (They may have changed due to 2021 Redistricting).

All of Becker County's Absentee ballots application submitted on-line or received in our office by 8/2/2022 have been mailed.
