

**Resolution Establishing Precincts and Polling Places
For Detroit Township, Becker County, Minnesota**

WHEREAS, the legislature of the State of Minnesota has been redistricted; and

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statute section 204B.14, subd. 3 (d) requires that precinct boundaries must be reestablished within 60 days of when the legislature has been redistricted or at least 19 weeks before the state primary election, whichever comes first;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of Detroit Township, County of Becker; State of Minnesota hereby establishes the boundaries of the voting precincts and polling places **for state and federal elections** as follows:

Precinct 1 (Community Alliance Church, 408 Elm Street West)

Township 139 Range 041 located within Becker County; excluding all of section 22, part of Section 23 West of Pelican River, part of Section 26 west of Pelican River and North of Highway 34, all of Section 27, part of Section 28 South of Highway 10, all of Sections 29, 32, 33, 34, 35, and Section 36 North of Lemon Road; East half of the Southeast quarter; and part of the Southwest quarter of the Southeast quarter at the end of Warnake Road and surrounded by Detroit Lakes Ward 1.

Excluding A triangular part of the township in the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter along the east side of Highway 59; and a square piece in part of Government Lot 7 Section 33 West of Highway 59, both surrounded by Detroit Lakes City Ward 3.

Precinct 2 (Community Alliance Church, 408 Elm Street West)


A triangular part of the township in the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter along the east side of Highway 59; and a square piece in part of Government Lot 7 Section 33 west of Highway 59, both surrounded by Detroit Lakes City Ward 3.

NOW, FURTHERMORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Detroit Township Board hereby designates Detroit Townhall located at 26134 N Tower Road, Detroit Lakes, MN as the polling location for the year 2022 *stand-alone elections*.



Township Chairman



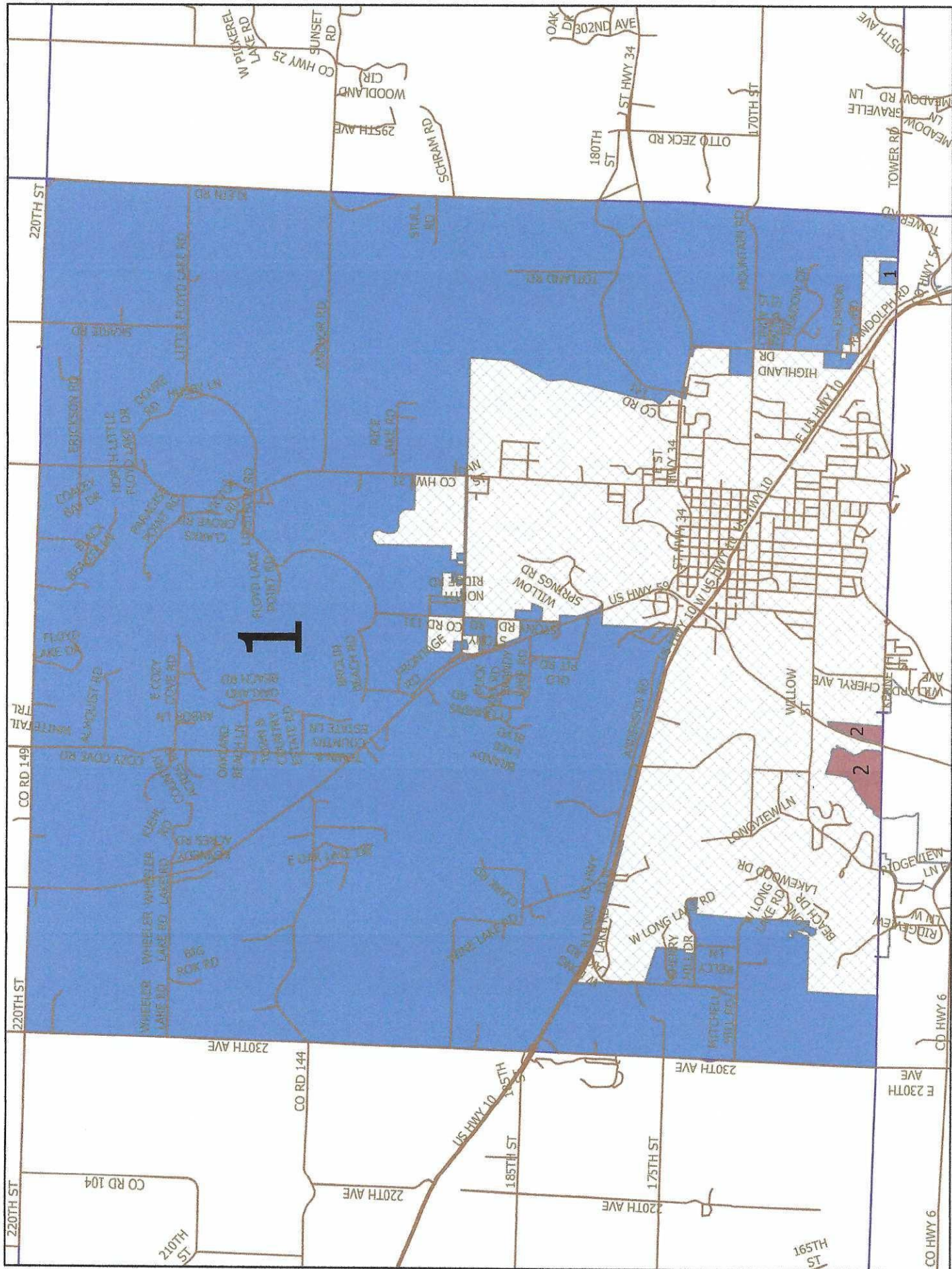
